The donor will also receive a permanent mention in the D.C. Ride Book in perpetuity.*
- All caballeros or friends of the Desert Caballeros Trail Ride are invited to make a 100% tax-deductible donation to the DCF in whatever amount they can afford. Ask your accountant for details.
- All caballeros are encouraged to leave a bequest to the Desert Caballeros Foundation in your will.
